MA DESE Post Secondary Chapter 74 Advanced Manufacturing Program

ENSATS was given full approval to begin a Chapter 74 Advanced Manufacturing post-secondary program. This process began last school year and continued through completion in January 2019. A special thank you to Bonnie Carr for working tirelessly with the MA DESE, instructional teachers, MassHire, and our local industry leaders to create additional learning opportunities for our adult learners. This designation allows these students to be counted toward Perkins and may result in an increase in Perkins grant funding in the future.

ExxonMobil Grant, \$500

The school was awarded a \$500 Exxon Mobil grant to be used for STEM learning. This grant was given to us through a recommendation of a local Exxon Mobil station. A thank you letter from the donor will be sent.
