MA DESE Exploratory Frameworks

Freshman Exploratory Frameworks are under review at this time. This project had two ENSATS staff members (Heidi Riccio and Brooks Clark) who assisted in the development. MA DESE added some language at the end which is concerning to Massachusetts Association of Vocational Administrators (MAVA) related to a lottery system of program acceptance.
